


# Special Edition Newsletter SURVIVING COVID-19 TOGETHER

# SPEECH TIPS AND TRICKS

-Work on following directions by having your child complete the simple everyday tasks with you such as laundry.

-Work on following directions by completing crafts or following recipes for slime, sensory bottles, or even fun snacks.

-Multi-Sensory activities are great for building language and keeping little ones busy. Mix items such as rice, beans, cotton balls, & toys together in one bin and let your little one explore. Model language throughout, talk about how things feel, what you see (colors, shapes). Hide items in the bin and play I Spy! This can entertain your little ones for a long time! Look up sensory bins on the internet and create them together!

-Finally, never underestimate the power of story time!!
